Parent Code of Conduct

To participate in Chippewa Strikers Soccer Club as a parent, I agree to the following:

1. I will treat my coaches, other players, opposing team's coaches, officials and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, religion or abilities.
2. I will refrain from criticizing any decisions made by my player's coaches and respect a 24 hour period before contacting the coach with concerns.
3. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices.
4. I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents by demonstrating good sportsmanship myself.
5. I will avoid saying or acting in any manner that will hurt, degrade or insult any player.
6. I will emphasize team success over my child's accomplishments.
7. I accept responsibility for all of my and my child's actions both on and off the field.
8. I accept responsibility for my guests that come to a Chippewa Strikers event on my behalf.
9. I understand that profanity is not allowed at any Chippewa Strikers event whether it is home or away.
10. I understand that I am representing Chippewa Strikers and will do my best to uphold the expectations placed upon me at all times, including, but not limited to, overnight trips.
11. I remember that my membership in Chippewa Strikers is a privilege and not a right. Violations of the Code of Conduct could result in my suspension or my child's registration being refused the following season.

Penalties for Code Violation

The Chippewa Strikers Soccer Club Board shall be responsible for investigating and enforcing all Formal Written Parent Code of Conduct violations. In the event a written violation is reported to the Board, the Board shall notify the parent and provide them with the opportunity to address the alleged violation. The Board shall then meet to consider all information relating to the violation and determine, in the Board's discretion, whether or not a violation occurred. No meeting shall be required if the parent admits the violation. If the parent disagrees with the decision of the Board, the parent may appeal, in writing, that decision to the Board within five business days. Said appeal shall state in specific in detail, the reason(s) why the Board reached an incorrect decision. The entire Board shall then convene to review the submissions and decide the appeal. The parent shall only be allowed to submit written argument for the Board to review and will not be allowed to appear at the Board Appeal Review meeting. The decision of the Board shall be final and non-appealable.

In the event a violation is found, the penalty shall be as follows:

- 1st Offense - A written reprimand.
- 2nd Offense - A one game suspension.
- 3rd Offense - Suspension from the remainder of the season.

All game suspensions must be completed prior to reinstatement.

The suspension will be implemented immediately after determination that a code violation has been made by the Chippewa Strikers Soccer Club Board.

The Code of Conduct is to be in full force on a year round basis, from registration to registration.
